The Software QA Tester role is an integral part of the IT department and eHealth's software development and release process. This role is responsible for the execution and hands on validation of Image Exchange releases, as well as certification of software readiness. This role acts as a conduit between eHealth Technologies technical teams and the external customers.

This position requires solid organizational skills and follow through. The person chosen for this opportunity will have experience working in a dynamic, fast paced, technical, team-oriented work environment that is guided by and upholds company core values.

**Primary Responsibilities:**

1. Executes functional test procedures and or scripts either manually or by automated tools.
2. Tracks and reports on the test execution in a timely manner with attention given to achieving a high level of quality.
3. Gathers and documents the outcome of test executions and all information needed to support ongoing measurements and reporting on risks, defects, tests, and coverage.

4. Ensures data is accurate, timely, and objective.
5. Reports discrepancies and analyzes them to determine the root causes. Elevates script failures at a high level.
6. Coordinates with Development and Infrastructure teams/peers on the resolution of issues, overseeing the testing progress and ensuring that high standards of quality are being met.
7. Compares and analyzes system behavior vs expected results based on business and technical requirements.
8. Identifies issues, proposes system improvements and performs repetitive test execution to resolve identified issues.
9. Evaluates test exit criteria to assess if additional tests are required or if test scenarios need to be adjusted.
10. Participates in and contributes to internal design reviews of testing materials.
11. Promote and adhere to all elements of the agency's Corporate Compliance and HIPAA policies.
12. Perform other related duties as required.
